



***Covenant Church / Covenant School
Arlington, Massachusetts***

Covenant Church occupies an historic building that was originally constructed as a single-story facility in 1899. In 1909, the Sanctuary level was raised by one floor and a Fellowship Hall was provided. In 1954, a three-story classroom addition was constructed. Covenant Church purchased the building in 1994. In 1996, Covenant School relocated their K-8 elementary school to the site.

In 2001, Mills Whitaker Architects performed an Assessment & Master Plan for the church and school. This study involved historic research, preparation of measured drawings, assessment of existing conditions and planning. Preliminary drawings and budgets were prepared to address phased renovations, improved utilization of existing space and handicap accessibility issues.

In 2003, Mills Whitaker Architects assisted with the implementation of Phase One of the Master Plan. The Phase One work involved renovation of the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall areas. These two key spaces represent the primary assembly and activity areas that serve both the church and school communities. In 2004, Phase Two design work commenced for the provision of handicap accessibility improvements.
