



***Park Street Church Welcome Center
Boston, Massachusetts***

Mills Whitaker Architects renovated the entrance level of the circa 1809 Park Street Church in celebration of the church's 200th anniversary. The renovation connected various parts of the church's urban campus to create a central gathering place that can serve myriad functions. On Sundays, the area is a welcome center for refreshments, fellowship and news about the church's ministries. At other times, it can be subdivided into several meeting rooms of varying sizes that can host multiple events.
